SPELLATHON 2013 RULES AND GUIDELINES

Rules

- 1. Upon arrival, the spellers will draw for his/her speller number randomly.
- 2. Rules will be read to spellers prior to competition, but it is highly recommended that spellers look over the rules prior to the contest date.
- 3. The SPELLATHON consists of only ORAL rounds. There is no written round.
- 4. During the first round, every speller should say his/her name, speller number and grade for the judges' record.
- 5. The first round will be a practice round. Each speller will spell a word and return to his/her seat during this round. There will be no elimination, even if a speller misspells a word.
- 6. After the first round, subsequent rounds will be elimination rounds.
- 7. Once the letters are spelled, the speller can restart his/her spelling after informing the judges, but he/she may not change the order of the letters already spelled.
- 8. If the speller correctly spells the word, he/she remains in the competition and returns to his/her seat.
- 9. If the speller does not spell the word correctly, he/she will return the number card to his/her respective seat and return to the audience.
- 10. Each speller remaining at the start of a round spells one word in each round.
- 11. There is no time limit for a speller to spell the word.
- 12. The speller can ask questions related to the word as per the guidelines provided
- 13.A speller should say the word before and after spelling the word as this helps the judges, but a speller will not be disqualified for failing to do so.
- 14. Majority of the words will be chosen from the spelling study lists that have been circulated to the participants.
- 15.Based on discretion, NSM GURUCOOL is entitled to use lists outside of the study material to determine the winners.
- 16. Championship Rounds: In order to win the competition, a speller must spell a word correctly in a round in which every other speller misspells, and then spell another word (championship word) correctly.

- 17. In case the speller misses the championship word, the spellers from the previous round return to the competition and the rounds will progress as before.
- 18.If everyone misspells in a round, they will all be reinstated into the competition.
- 19.If only one speller spells correctly in a round with three or more spellers and he/she correctly spells his/her championship word, everyone who misspelled in the previous round will compete for 2nd and 3rd places.
- 20. The top three winners in each category (Senior & Junior) will be awarded 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} places, respectively.
- 21. All other students will be recognized with a participation trophy.
- 22. The decision of the judges is final.

Guidelines

- 1. Participants are requested to learn the pronunciations, definitions and other details of the words while studying them.
- 2. Some words have alternate pronunciations. It is good to know all pronunciations of the word while preparing for the competition.
- 3. Participants are encouraged to take time, think and spell the word.
- 4. If the word has a homonym, the pronouncer will provide the relevant information
- 5. The Speller may ask the following questions about the word:
 - Definition of the word
 - Pronunciation of the word
 - Use the word in a sentence
 - Language of origin for the word
 - Part of speech of the word
 - Alternate Pronunciation
 - Repeat the word
